Dear Parishioners,

Thanks to everyone who took the time to fill out your Annual Catholic Appeal pledge card after Mass last weekend. If you have not yet done so, we have mailed your card to you. Please take a minute to fill out your pledge card and return it in the return envelope or simply place it in our collection basket. Even if you are not able to participate this year, we ask that you please sign your card. No gift is too small or too large. I try to inch up my own pledge each year in my own personal commitment.

Recently, on a Saturday afternoon, at our 4 o'clock Mass, we commissioned Stephen ministers who are available to the people of our parish. Our Stephen ministers serve as spiritual companions to individuals and families who are recovering from loss or crisis in their lives. These are not counselors or social workers, but men and women who have been trained to assist those who are trying to make sense of their lives after having suffered a death, a crisis, a miscarriage, a divorce, a loss of a job or a home. A Stephen minister might share their journey for a few days or weeks or even months. Their purpose is not be intrusive in any way; but to offer solace, companionship and support to those who are feeling a bit lost in their journey of life and faith.

We are blessed to have a dedicated team of 24 trained Stephen ministers here at Holy Infant. If you would like to talk to one of the members of our team, please contact me at the rectory (636-227-7440) and I would be happy to make the connection for you.

On another note, congratulations to the Holy Infant School graduates of 2017, as well as those who graduated from our Parish School of Religion program. Many years of hard work and dedication have gone into this achievement, not just by our students, but by parents and teachers as well. We thank all our parishioners who, by their prayers and financial support, have made the education of our young people a high priority!

Finally, our Closing Mass for the last day of the school year will be on Friday, May 26<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 a.m. If you have ever attended one of our end-of-the-school year liturgies, you know what a grand and memorable celebration it is! All are most welcome and encouraged to attend this special all-school liturgy as we thank our loving God for our many blessings here at Holy Infant!

**The Little Sisters of the Poor**, who have been welcoming aged poor persons and sharing their lives with them within our Archdiocese for over 140 years, will be visiting our parish Saturday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> and Sunday, June 4<sup>th</sup> to speak of their mission within the Church, and to ask our help. Their Home, in North St. Louis, currently serves 115 needy elderly persons, age 65 or older, who are loved and cared for until death, so that they live in security and dignity.

The heart of their mission is simply to provide a "Home", so that those elderly, with whom the sisters joyfully share their lives, realize how much God loves them and wants them to be with Him forever in heaven. Throughout their history, the Little Sisters have depended on the collaboration of the laity to enable them to support their Residents and live their vocation. The Sisters will have envelopes in the pews and will briefly speak at Mass to ask your support. Please make checks payable to the Little Sisters of the Poor.

Last summer, the Sisters announced that they will be leaving the Archdiocese after 148 years. They have no intention of doing so until they find the "right" people to continue their mission to the poor. For that reason, there is no date set for their departure. In the meantime, Archbishop Carlson understands that they must continue to beg in order to keep the "Home fires burning" so that the work continues.

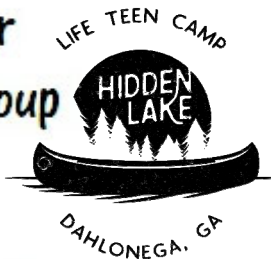

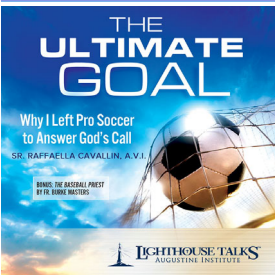

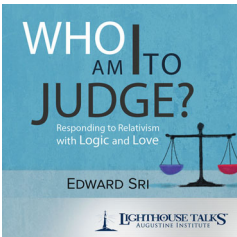

## New Lighthouse Kiosk-New Lighthouse CDs



Sister Raffaella Cavallin, a consecrated lay-person with the Apostles of the Interior Life, shares her inspiring spiritual journey. At the height of her professional soccer career, while attending a parish mission, she discovered that the ultimate goal in life is to become a saint. Sister Raffaella's story illustrates how holiness and happiness go hand in hand, and that through prayer, the Sacraments, and spiritual direction, we can live a Christ centered life and become the person God wants us to be.

Fr. Mike Schmitz shares important insights on the meaning of Christ's Cross. He shows how God's rescue mission for us includes the need for each person to embrace his own cross in order to reestablish trust in the Father and the understanding that love requires sacrifice. It also includes a bonus segment on Stations of the Cross, which features reflections on the Lord's Passion and Death, accompanied by moving audio dramatizations from the Truth and Life Audio Bible.


